Curriculum

The curriculum is comprised of general education courses and professional nursing courses. Students can be admitted to the nursing component each session. Requirements for entry include a minimum of a “C” in all required general education courses and a GPA of 2.7 (on a 4.0 scale) on required pre-requisite courses.

School of Nursing application deadlines for the RN to BS in Nursing program are December 1st for the Spring, July 15 for the Fall, and May 1st for the Summer.

The nursing component consists of 18 hours required nursing courses and 12 hours of nursing elective courses of your choice, allowing you to individualize your nursing curriculum.
